GAYS PUT MRS

MOPPS IN PANIC ON AIDS

A THEATRE'S Mrs Mopps want gay actors banned from their stage — because they are afraid of catching AIDS.

The cleaners fear that sweeping up after a show by a troupe called Gay Sweatshop could put them at risk.

Alex Scott, director of the Taliesan Theatre in Swansea, Glamorgan, said he had issued the cleaners with rubber gloves and bottles of disinfectant.

He added: "They were upset that they might catch AIDS, but we had a meeting and I explained that you only catch it from sexual contact."

Advice

"The chances of sex between the women and the actors is remote, to say the least."

POLICE leaders have followed fire chiefs in seeking medical advice on whether officers may get AIDS when giving the kiss of life.

Health union COHSE, which has most of Britain's ambulancemen as members, said it was "watching the situation very closely."
