Penrose Inquiry SNBTS Blood Collection 1975 – 1991

2. From which penal institutions in each region were donations collected?

Please see table attached (Prisons in each Scottish Blood transfusion Region visited by SNBTS).

3. Were donations from penal institutions put to any particular use or did they simply form part of the general pool?

All donations collected from penal institutions were treated in exactly the same way as donations from any other donor session and formed part of the general donor pool.

4. Were donations from penal institutions sent to the Protein Fractionation Centre (PFC) for the manufacture of blood products?

Yes. As donations from penal institutions formed part of the general pool, they were treated in the same manner as all other donations and were sent to the PFC for processing.

Also on 5 January 2011 Gregor Mair wrote 'it would be very helpful if Table 2 of the SNBTS response could be expanded to show the number of donations in the years 1971 to 1974 inclusive'.

Table 2 of the SNBTS response, sent to the Penrose Inquiry on 20 December 2010, has been expanded to include the data for 1971 to 1974 that are available. An updated version of this table is attached (Table 2: Donations collected in each Scottish RTC 1971-1991).

This table has been expanded to include donations collected in the years 1971 to 1974 inclusive, where these figures are available. No donation numbers are available from the South East RTC (Edinburgh) for 1971 to 1974 and the total number of donations collected in the North East RTC (Aberdeen) in 1971 is also not available. Consequently we are not able to present the total number of Scottish donations for this period.

The total number of donations collected in penal institutions (excluding prison donation numbers from Inverness RTC) has been updated to include the total number of donations from 1974, but the numbers of donations collected in penal institutions during the years 1971 to 1973 inclusive for the West RTC, the East RTC and the NE RTC are not available. For clarity an updated version of Table 1 of the SNBTS response, sent to the Penrose Inquiry on 20 December 2010, (titled Table 1: Donations collected at Penal Institutes in each Scottish RTC 1971-1984) is attached.
