Hepatitis Surveillance
Survey in Haemophilia

You will recall that on the occasion of the last Haemophilia and Transfusion Directors' meeting Dr. John Craske from Manchester explained to us that he wished to extend his prospective survey of hepatitis in haemophiliacs by including patients receiving Scottish factor VIII concentrates.

I write to let you know that as of January 1st 1978, Dr. Sheena Parker in this department has been asked to follow up all reported cases from Scotland. We believe this will remove much of the paper work burden from you and your colleagues, and that such an arrangement will satisfy Dr. Craske.

As all cases are initially reported to the Protein Fractionation Centre, Dr. Parker will obtain information directly from Mr. Watt and his colleagues, or Regional Transfusion Directors in the case of hepatitis developing in the occasional patient receiving cryoprecipitate, exclusively.
