BRIEFING NOTE FOR JDC

(Per telephone conversation between RS and SDS 21/1/92)

MONDAY 20 JANUARY 1992

a.m. Prior to Coag. Working Party Meeting at 11.00

1. Dr Ludlam contacted Dr Murphy asking for more F8.
2. Dr Murphy immediately contacted RS.
3. RS contacted PFC but Dianne Innes not available (late shift) so went to Coag Meeting without knowing answer

Post Coag. Meeting

4. Upon return to office after Coag. Meeting, RS was telephoned by Dianne Innes who stated availability was 57,000 i.u. RS pointed out that RP had submitted a figure of 500,000 to Coag Meeting. Dianne Innes did not know reason for this.
5. RS contacted RP who stated that he had given the meeting his projected month end figure as expecting a supply from Lille.

Nothing further was done on Monday.

Tuesday 21 January '92

6. Dr Murphy telephoned RS to say Dr Ludlam had been in touch with him to say that as RP had told meeting he had 500,000 i.u., could he please have some more.
7. RS then telephoned RP and discussed how much French F8 was really available. RP confirmed that a delivery from Lille was due this week. RS agreed to check with Dr Ludlam re progress of pilot study with "semi-tartan" F8 so this could be released. (It was not being used so far as pilot data not complete.)
8. RS then phoned Dr Ludlam re progress on pilot study and explained that only 57,000 i.u of French F8 were available.

Dr Ludlam responded abruptly that he was late for a patient and that "RP created the problem. He should sort it out".

9. RS contacted RP who agreed to send 57,000 i.u to Dr Ludlam, and claim back further 100 vials from West BTS for supply to South East. RS agreed with this as currently no stock problem in West BTS.
10. RS sent message to Dr Ludlam again and reported this. Dr Ludlam thanked RS via his secretary.
