GAYS are to be asked to stop giving blood — in case it is infected with the killer disease.

AIDS
The Health Department confirmed last night that special leaflets were being prepared for blood donor centres.

It is thought these will list the types of people most likely to catch AIDS, which includes gays and drug addicts.

They will be asked to

stop giving blood until more research is done into the disease.

There are no tests to detect AIDS in blood and it is thought it could be passed on through transfusions.

There have been 14 AIDS cases in Britain so far. Five have proved fatal.
