Of the 636 we know that at least 24 are deceased (although realistically speaking it is likely to be more). It probably goes without saying but all of the 636 on the balance of probabilities were chronically infected with hepatitis C through blood or blood products (231 blood products for haemophilia, 405 whole blood or platelets etc.)

15 of the 636 stage one payments went to an estate
 15 of the 134 stage two payments went to an estate

Because this data relies on the database being maintained accurately (date of death being entered) it cannot be said to be 100% accurate, it is possible that one or two more of the 636 £20k payments and 134 £25k payments went to an estate but it gives you a pretty accurate indication.
