REVENUE ALLOCATIONS 1983 - 84, BLOOD TRANSFUSION SERVICE, RECOMMENDATIONS OF MEDICINES INSPECTORATE

In terms of paragraph 2(c) and 4(b) of Annex A to the letter of 14 March 1983 from Robertson, Scottish Office Finance Division, which intimated the revenue allocations for 1983-84 for the Common Services Agency, I am writing to request that additional provision be made to the Agency for the purpose of meeting the cost of developments in the Blood Transfusion Service arising from the recommendations of the Medicines Inspectorate.

The specific, costed proposals are set out in the Annex to this letter, from which you will note that the total additional provision being requested is £87,233 recurring and £106,570 non-recurring. The proposals have been approved in principle by the Management Committee.

I should be grateful if early confirmation of the level of approved funding could be given to enable the developments to be set in hand although it is appreciated that the Department will wish to give further consideration to certain of the proposals including their eligibility for funding from the sources requested.

I am copying this letter to Robertson so that he is aware of the position.
